POPE BENEDICT XVI

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI has returned to the Father's House.

The Holy See Press Office an-

nounced that the Pope Emeritus died at 9:34 a.m. on Saturday morning in his residence at the Mater Ecclesiae Monastery, which the 95-year-old Pope emeritus had chosen as his residence after resigning from the Petrine ministry in 2013.

BENEDICT XVI: THE POPE EMERITUS

This excellent new documentary produced in Europe on the life and



papacy of Pope Benedict XVI (Joseph Ratzinger) shows us the great milestones of his life: renowned theology professor, prolific author, expert at the Second Vatican Council, longtime collaborator of John Paul II, and his pontificate that ended with a surprise: his resignation at the age of 86 years old. His battles for defending the faith and for transparency within the Church provoked both support and criticism. It was a long Way of the Cross for this great churchman that ended with a master lesson of humility, giving way to his successor.



BENEDICT XVI: A LOVE AFFAIR WITH THE TRUTH

A compelling inside look at the life and times of Joseph Ratzinger and the challenging pontificate of Pope

Benedict XVI. This biographical documentary covers his childhood, his rise within the Catholic Church, and the first few years of his papacy as the Vicar of Christ.
