Throughout the school year we provide opportunities for our students to understand our call to be "persons for others" through various service projects. We also encourage them to suggest projects as they see a need. Below are the projects they worked on during Advent:

Our pre-K class raised over \$300 for Crisis Nursery. One of our students made beaded bracelets with the words "Be Kind," to stress kindness in preparation for Christmas. The class provided the opportunity for the other students to participate in the "Be Kind" theme by purchasing a beaded bracelet for \$1. The entire pre-K class made the bracelets with the help of their 6th grade friends during the last week of Advent. Both classes gave the donation to the Crisis Nursery representatives on January 8th. They also learned about the important service that the Crisis Nursery provides in our community.

Students in K, 1st & 3rd grades brought in items needed by the Champaign County Humane Society. The 2nd & 4th graders raised money for Daily Bread Soup Kitchen (DBSK) by hosting a bake sale. Middle school students collected gently used items such as gloves, hats, and blankets to benefit the Canteen Run sponsored by the Salvation Army and Austin's Place, an overnight winter emergency shelter for women. Also, our students continued to provide milk and fruit to the DBSK each week during Advent. We are so proud of our students & families' commitment to the DBSK for the past 20 years!
