ADA UPDATE AS OF DECEMBER 31ST

Thanks to the generosity of some parish families, we have exceeded our goal of \$106,673. A total of \$123,042 has been pledged, and \$111,450 has been paid. If everyone fulfills their pledges, we will receive an ADA refund of \$16,369 which we will use to re-upholster our pews.

YOUR CHILD CAN ATTEND A CATHOLIC SCHOOL. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2020-21 school year.

It will be for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the school office or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only. Anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2020-21 school year must reapply.

Deadline for the completed application is April 15th, 2020. Notification of grant awards will be made by the end of June, 2020.


