




A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK (1:21-28)

Then they came to Capernaum, and on the sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes. In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" Jesus rebuked him and said, "Quiet! Come out of him!" The unclean spirit convulsed him and with a loud cry came out of him. All were amazed and asked one another, "What is this? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him." His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee.

FROM THE BOOK OF DEUTERONOMY (18:15-20)

Moses spoke to all the people, saying: "A prophet like me will the Lord, your God, raise up for you from among your own kin; to him you shall listen. This is exactly what you requested of the Lord, your God, at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, 'Let us not again hear the voice of the Lord, our God, nor see this great fire any more, lest we die.' And the Lord said to me, "This was well said. I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their kin, and will put my words into his mouth; he shall tell them all that I command him. Whoever will not listen to my words which he speaks in my name, I myself will make him answer for it. But if a prophet presumes to speak in my name an oracle that I have not commanded him to speak, or speaks in the name of other gods, he shall die."

UPDATED ONLINE GIVING

Did you know that not only can you give online to the various Holy Cross funds such as Sunday & Holy Days Collections, Development Fund, Online Giving Tuition Assistance, etc., but also to all Diocesan collections? It is very

handy for those who no longer receive packets of Church envelopes. This is a convenient way to stay up to date with Diocesan extra collections during the whole year.

Visit the Holy Cross website (www.holycrosscatholic.org) and click on **Online Giving** logo, and you will see all funds to which you can donate. Please note that among other funds you will currently see the Aid to Eastern Europe Churches. This is one of the Diocesan collections scheduled for February and it will remain active until the end of the month. Later on, this fund will be replaced by the new Diocesan collection, Catholic Relief Services. The new fund will remain active during the month of March. Following the same pattern, according to the Diocesan schedule, the next collection's fund will be activated for a short period of time on the Online Giving platform. In this way, you will always know what the current Diocesan collection is.

ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL

The 2020 Annual Diocesan Appeal is doing well. To date, we stand at 90% toward our goal. We have received pledges totaling \$95,918 toward our goal of \$106,103.
