

A SECOND COLLECTION FOR CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF CHAMPAIGN AND PIATT COUNTIES will be taken on May 31st / June 1st.

Catholic Charities of Champaign and Piatt counties provides support for those in need in Champaign and Piatt counties through our Food Pantry at St. Patrick's Parish Hall in Tolono, and our Light of Hope and Parish Ministry of Financial Help programs. In the last six months of our fiscal year, we have been able to donate over \$16,000 to help families and individuals with rent and utility assistance. During this same period, over 400 families (including 55 new families) have made 883 visits to our Food Pantry, where they receive food, emotional support and referrals to other resources. All our services are free.

Our Food Pantry is open Mondays, 4-6:30 p.m. and Fridays, 9-10:30 a.m. to serve those who are struggling to make ends meet and feed their families, regardless of where they live - grandparents raising grandchildren, young mothers raising small children, while working full-time and caring for a disabled husband, and seniors living on fixed incomes.

THE PASSION OF SAINT JOAN OF ARC

The Passion of Saint Joan of Arc is a documentary that was released on the

centennial of the canonization of the Maid of Orleans (May 16, 1920). This brave young woman with a unique mission reminds us just how important it is that Jesus Christ be the King of our nation, of the entire world, and of our hearts. She carried out her mission in absolute fidelity and confidence in God's will, revealed to her by her "voices". Hers is not a life of mere heroism, but rather a model of holiness, of complete surrender to God's will to the point of sacrificing her own life at only 19 years of age.



JOAN OF ARC

Although she died at nineteen in 1431, her legend and legacy is stronger than ever five hundred years later. Leelee Sobieski shines

as the legendary warrior and saint, Joan of Arc, who, at seventeen, led one of the greatest military campaigns for freedom the world has ever witnessed. Supported by an all-star cast, with glorious cinematography, music score, and stunning scenery, Joan of Arc is a riveting epic film of faith, inspiration, triumph, and tears. Born to a peasant French family, Joan hears the voices of saints calling out to her to unite her besieged nation.

Gaining an audience with the young French king, Joan convinces him that God is calling her to command an army into battle to save France. It becomes an incredible adventure that leads to thrilling victories and heartbreaking betrayals as Joan of Arc defies all odds and marches into history.

This movie is not rated, but was created with an adult audience in mind. It may contain violence indicative of the life and times of the saint or character portrayed. We would recommend Parental Guidance..
