


Church of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross



The Feast Day of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, is a feast established in 2018 by Pope Francis to be celebrated every year upon the Monday following Pentecost.

"In this way, the Church specifically recalls Mary's reception of the Holy Spirit with the Apostles at Pentecost, as well as her desire to protect all who come to her Son in His Holy Church," writes Father David Fons.

"The many mysteries of Jesus' life that Mary pondered were brought to full understanding in her heart at Pentecost. As the Church was fully established in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, strengthening the Lord's followers to believe in and to proclaim the Gospel, the Blessed Mother was there as the foremost example of what it means to fully say yes to Jesus."

Although the feast day is new, devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, under the title of Mother of the Church, is very ancient. Upon creating the feast in 2018, Pope Francis said he wished to "encourage the growth of the maternal sense of the Church in the pastors, religious and faithful, as well as a growth of genuine Marian piety".

"Our new feast day is an invitation for each of us to receive more from Mary's example of holiness and from the grace of her Son that she offers us," writes Father Fons, "Let us not be afraid to ask her prayers for ourselves and for the whole Church: O Mary, Mother of Christ, and Mother of the Church, pray for us that we might be made worthy of the promises of your Son!"



MISSIONARY APPEAL FOR THE DIOCESE OF RULENGE-NGARA, TANZANIA

Holy Cross Parish will be conducting its annual Missionary Appeal to support the Diocese of

Rulenge-Ngara in Tanzania, the home diocese of Fr. Remi and Fr. Leo. This diocese, in the northwestern part of Tanzania, serves a population of over a million people. This includes 334,000 Catholics and 30 parishes. Many of these people live on an income of under \$1 a day and survive on only one meal a day. The hardships they face include a lack of clean and safe water, lack of funds to train seminarians, and a lack of funds to support children in the Orphanage Centre.

Any funds we are able to provide will help them drill and construct two wells and three water reservoirs (\$15,000 per well), contribute to the tuition of seminarians (\$2,000 per seminarian), and support their orphanage (there are currently 168 orphans in their care). Fr. Leo and Bishop Niwemugizi of the Rulenge-Ngara Diocese extend their deepest gratitude for any spiritual or financial support you are able to provide. The collection will be taken up June 25th/26th.

Bless the families of our fallen troops, and fill their homes and their lives with your strength and peace.


