

Totus Tuus is open to all students entering into 1st through 12th grades in the Fall of 2025. There are two tracks:

The Day Program (9:00 am-2:30 pm) for those entering Grades 1-6 meet Monday, June 9 thru Friday, June 13

The Evening Program (6:30 pm-8:15 pm) for those entering Grades 7-12 meet Sunday, June 8 thru Thursday, June 12

The Day Program will enjoy skits, games, prayer, daily Mass, and much more!

The Evening Program will enjoy games, thought-provoking talks, opportunities to have their questions answered, and snacks galore!

The cost is \$50 per child for the Day Program and \$25 per child for the Evening Program.

Please note that children will need to bring a bag lunch each day for the Day Program. In addition, we ask that each child bring a snack to share for the week (e.g. crackers, cookies, pretzels).

To register, please complete the forms (available in the church or school & parish offices) and return them to the Holy Cross parish office, attn: Totus Tuus.

In order to make Totus Tuus a memorable and positive experience for all the youth of our parish, we need your help! Please prayerfully consider how God may be calling you to help make the week a success.

We need both adults and teens to help during the Day Program. This consists of a kitchen crew to help with lunch and snacks. We also need plenty of classroom helpers to assist the Totus Tuus team with classroom activities and keeping a watchful eye on the children.

Adult volunteers: Please complete the Adult Volunteer Registration Form. Adult volunteers also need to meet the Safe Environment requirements for the Diocese of Peoria. If you need any of the training, simply indicate that in the form and we will be happy to help you with this!

Youth volunteers: Please complete the Youth Volunteer Registration Form. IMPORTANT NOTE: The Diocese of Peoria requires that teens who volunteer during the day for service hours must also attend the evening sessions.

Catholic Charities

A SECOND COLLECTION FOR **CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF** CHAMPAIGN AND PIATT COUNTIES Diocese of Peoria Champaign-Piatt Counties will be taken on May 31st / June 1st

Catholic Charities of Champaign and Piatt counties provides support for those in need in Champaign and Piatt counties through our Food Pantry at St. Patrick's Parish Hall in Tolono, and our Light of Hope and Parish Ministry of Financial Help programs. In the last six months of our fiscal year, we have been able to donate over \$16,000 to help families and individuals with rent and utility assistance. During this same period, over 400 families (including 55 new families) have made 883 visits to our Food Pantry, where they receive food, emotional support and referrals to other resources. All our services are free.

Our Food Pantry is open Mondays, 4-6:30 p.m. and Fridays, 9-10:30 a.m. to serve those who are struggling to make ends meet and feed their families, regardless of where they live – grandparents raising grandchildren, young mothers raising small children, while working full-time and caring for a disabled husband, and seniors living on fixed incomes.


We arranged for two of our families to have supplemental food thru the St. Vincent de Paul food pantry at Holy Cross. Thank you so much!
