# Eucharistic Revival

"A couple of weeks ago, the little children I am privileged to teach received the Eucharist for the first time. A few days later, I invited them to share what they felt in their hearts when they received Jesus. Most of the children had a powerful emotion to share—for some excitement, for others happiness and joy.

Yet, I was most moved by the responses of two little girls who remarked that they didn't feel anything at all. I was so impressed by their sincerity and asked them whether, despite not having felt anything, they had *encountered* Jesus. In their own way, both girls responded that yes, indeed, Jesus had come to them. They knew that Jesus is real. Jesus loves them.

As we continue this journey of Eucharistic Revival, let us learn from these innocent little children a pivotal lesson: encountering Jesus is not about a feeling we may experience or want to experience. Our feelings do not prove that we have had an encounter. Encounter is about a relationship. In good times and bad times, whether we feel it or not, Jesus is with us and we are with him. He doesn't judge our emotions, because emotions are neither good nor bad. But, he wants to help purify our motives.

Brothers and sisters, let's ask Jesus today, right now, to help us seek him for himself. Just as Jesus has given himself for us, let us give ourselves completely for him—and through him, for one another.

May Mary, Mother of the Eucharist, help us enter more completely into communion with each other through Jesus. May our bond of unity be the joyful witness that draws those who have wandered far away from the Eucharist back to the Source and Summit of our Christian life!"

# FATHER LEO'S TANZANIA WELL PROJECT

Father Leo is raising funds to support the drilling of a well to provide a dedicated local source of clean drinking water to the Kiziramuyaga Primary School in his village in Tanzania. The school serves 900 students and staff, as well as the surrounding community.

The lack of nearby clean water means women and girls spend many hours each day walking long distances to carry buckets of water back to the school and village. The cost of the project including drilling, installation of pipes & pump, construction of a reservoir water tank, and solar panel installation to power the pump is approximately \$25,000.

To date, our SVdP conference has raised half of this amount from a small group of parishioners at Holy Cross and St. Matthew. If you would like to help, please make your check payable to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and include "Tanzania Well Project" in the memo portion of the check. Checks can be mailed to the Holy Cross Church office or dropped in the collection basket.
